A. Purpose and Scope

At Togg, our ambition is to redefine sustainable mobility through a user-centric and open ecosystem.

Our world is calling for sustainable solutions and we're more than listening, we fight for sustainability. We lead by Togg's Truzero sustainability strategy, embedding sustainability in how we design and build our products, processes, and our ecosystem.

This policy has been published to define core principles to be followed in all our decisions and actions throughout the entire value chain, from product design to business partner management after-sales processes; as well as to inform our stakeholders in this regard. Togg Climate and Environment Policy is binding for "Togg - Türkiye'nin Otomobili Girişim Grubu Sanayi ve Ticaret A.Ş." and its subsidiaries, their respective executives, and associates as well as for its business partners, contractors, and stakeholders.

Environment and climate-related issues are prioritized as integral parts of our Truzero strategy and operations. In line with the Paris Agreement and Türkiye's Net Zero target, Togg is committed to achieving **a carbon-neutral mobility ecosystem by 2035** and **net zero emissions by 2050**. We have incorporated these priorities into our SMAP (Strategy Map), decision-making processes, resource allocation, and long-term planning. Through dedicated initiatives, we strive to minimize our environmental footprint, mitigate climate impact, and promote sustainability across our three business pillars: Smart Mobility Devices, Digital Experience Platform Trumore, and Clean Energy Solutions. We prioritize environmentally friendly practices and continuously seek opportunities for improvement. Our commitment to environmental stewardship extends beyond compliance requirements, driving us to proactively pursue user-centric and innovative solutions and partnerships that contribute to a healthier planet for future generations.

B. Definitions

Truzero: is Togg's sustainability strategy which outlines the approach and actions that Togg plans to take to address environmental, social, and economic issues on its way to achieving net zero emissions by 2050 and carbon neutral mobility ecosystem by 2035.

Sustainability: is ability to meet the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs. At Togg, sustainability involves balancing economic, environmental, and social considerations to ensure long-term well-being and resilience for both people and the planet.

Business Partner (BP): is a person, company, or organization that provides goods or services to Togg. Beyond a traditional supplier relationship, Togg considers its Business Partners an integral part of its mobility ecosystem, fostering collaboration on equal footing to achieve shared goals and create long-term value.

Board of Directors (Board): Board is the highest governance body of Togg, providing oversight, approving strategic decisions, safeguarding shareholder interests, and guiding Togg's long term direction.

Cockpit: Cockpit is the strategic decision-making body, bringing together C-level executives to define Togg's vision, mission, and strategic goals, make critical business decisions, and oversee the execution of Togg objectives.

Truzero Owner: refers to business owners at Togg who implement the company's sustainability strategy, develop innovative solutions to reduce environmental impacts, and take responsibility for achieving corporate ESG goals. This team consists of leaders and team members playing a critical role in executing all projects that support Togg's Truzero goals.

Workstream: A designated business function within Togg, accountable for managing and delivering objectives, actions, and performance outcomes within its area of responsibility.

OKR (Objectives and Key Results): A goal-setting and performance management framework used at Togg to align strategic objectives with measurable outcomes and track progress across workstreams and initiatives.

C. Core Principles

1. Protecting the climate and the environment is a core responsibility of each Togg associate regardless of their position. We carry out environmental and climate management with a division of responsibility extending from Board and Cockpit to the operational units, and with governance bodies established at strategic and operational level.
2. Strategic oversight of climate change and environmental sustainability at Togg is led by the Board and the Cockpit, which oversee governance, implementation, and decision-making. Truzero Owners Committee provides strategic coordination, monitors progress, and supports the effective implementation of Togg's sustainability strategy, while each Workstream is accountable for managing environmental and climate-related issues within their areas.
3. We comply with all applicable environmental legislation, permit conditions, mandatory standards, and other binding obligations in every country where we operate. We proactively monitor regulatory developments and implement internationally recognized environmental and climate management standards and frameworks to ensure compliance and continuously improve our performance throughout the lifecycle of our operations, products, and services.
4. We provide regular training and awareness programs to strengthen our associates' knowledge, skills, and competencies in sustainability, ESG, and compliance-related matters, fostering a culture of continuous learning and responsible business conduct. Every Togg associate also completes an online orientation program before starting their role, covering sustainability, company culture, our working principles, and ethical standards.
5. We closely follow the international agenda on environmental and climate-related issues. We actively engage with our associates, business partners, customers, local communities, academia, public institutions and civil society organizations to strengthen environmental awareness, promote knowledge sharing, foster collaboration, and build capacity through training, dialogue and partnerships that support climate and environmental action. Through our agile collaboration approach, we collaborate with startups and women entrepreneurs to advance innovation and contribute to a more inclusive and sustainable future.
6. Every Togg visitor in production facilities take HSE training during their visit. They have the right to question an actual behavior which they think that may pose an instant environmental hazard.

7. We identify, assess, and monitor climate and environment-related risks and opportunities through our corporate risk management framework. We evaluate their potential financial impacts and incorporate the results into Togg's strategic planning and decision-making processes, enabling management and primary users of the financial statements to make informed strategic decisions.
8. We identify, measure and regularly monitor our significant environmental impacts, including energy consumption, greenhouse gas emissions, air emissions, water use, material and chemical consumption, waste generation and biodiversity impacts.
9. We establish measurable environmental and climate objectives, targets, and OKRs, regularly monitor and evaluate our performance, transparently disclose our progress, and continuously improve our environmental management practices. We implement internal controls and, where appropriate, independent assurance to ensure the effectiveness of our management systems and the reliability of our environmental data and disclosures.
10. We encourage and incentivize environmentally responsible and climate friendly behaviors, improvement ideas, projects and performance achievements across Togg ecosystem.
11. As a born-electric, born-digital and born-clean mobility company, we continuously invest in innovative products, technologies and processes to minimize environmental impacts throughout their lifecycle. Powered by ingenuity and electricity, we engineer a sustainable ecosystem designed to connect more people to more opportunities that protect the places where we work, live, and explore. We allocate the necessary resources to support innovation and continuous environmental improvement.
12. We are committed to progressively increasing the share of renewable electricity across our operations and supporting our long-term ambition to source 100% renewable electricity through on-site generation and credible renewable energy procurement mechanisms.
13. We are committed to continuously improving our energy efficiency by reducing energy intensity across our operations. To achieve this, we develop reliable and efficient energy systems, conduct preventive and predictive maintenance, monitor energy performance and losses, ensure energy continuity, and implement appropriate measures to address energy-related risks and disruptions.

14. We regularly quantify and monitor significant direct and indirect greenhouse gas emissions across our value chain and implement initiatives to reduce emissions and improve carbon efficiency. In line with the Paris Agreement and Türkiye's Net Zero target, Togg is committed to achieving net zero emissions by 2050 and a carbon-neutral mobility ecosystem by 2035.
15. We are committed to preventing, controlling and continuously reducing water pollution by minimizing wastewater generation, ensuring effective treatment before discharge and protecting receiving water bodies and ecosystems.
16. We are committed to continuously reducing freshwater withdrawal by improving water efficiency, increasing water reuse and recycling, and implementing sustainable water management practices across our operations.
17. We support access to safely managed water, sanitation and hygiene (WASH) within our operations and, where appropriate, collaborate with our stakeholders to support water stewardship and contribute to healthier, more resilient communities.
18. We apply a life cycle approach to waste management by preventing waste generation, reducing waste at source, promoting reuse and recycling, and maximizing resource recovery in accordance with circular economy principles.
19. We are committed to minimizing the use of hazardous chemicals by promoting safer alternatives, improving chemical management practices and ensuring their safe handling, storage, transportation, use and disposal throughout their lifecycle.
20. We ensure the responsible management of chemicals throughout our operations and products by complying with applicable legislation, including the EU REACH Regulation and other relevant automotive industry standards, where applicable. We continuously improve our chemical management practices to minimize risks to human health and the environment.
21. We support the transition to a circular economy by improving resource efficiency, maximizing the use of recycled and responsibly sourced materials, and promoting sustainable consumption of natural resources throughout the lifecycle of our products and operations.

22. We are committed to protecting biodiversity and natural ecosystems by avoiding, minimizing and managing the environmental impacts of our operations, products and value chain, while integrating nature-positive principles into our business decisions.
23. We are committed to preventing deforestation and forest degradation across our operations and value chain by identifying, assessing, and managing forest-related risks.
24. We promote responsible and, wherever possible, sustainable sourcing of wood, paper, cardboard, natural rubber, and other forest-based materials, while enhancing value chain traceability and transparency.
25. We expect our business partners to comply with applicable environmental legislation, protect natural ecosystems, and provide transparency regarding the origin of forest-risk commodities.
26. We continuously strengthen our due diligence and business partner engagement practices to improve traceability, support sustainable land management, and contribute to the conservation and restoration of forests and biodiversity.
27. We work with business partners that share our environmental and sustainability values. We integrate environmental and climate-related criteria into our procurement and supplier management processes, monitor our business partners' environmental performance, and support their capability development, decarbonization journey and technology transformation through collaboration, knowledge sharing and capacity-building initiatives.
28. We promote an inclusive and respectful culture in the implementation of our climate and environmental commitments. We ensure that environmental decision-making and sustainability initiatives are carried out in a manner that encourages participation, and provides equal opportunities for all associates and stakeholders. We do not tolerate discrimination, harassment or exclusion on any grounds and foster awareness to support an inclusive transition to a sustainable future.

D. Reporting

We periodically report our practices, achievements and future goals on environment and climate-related issues to the Cockpit and other relevant governance bodies through OKRs and internal reports, to public authorities through regulatory reporting, and to relevant external stakeholders through appropriate communication and disclosure channels.
